The NRS-H scholarship fund is pleased to announce our 2021 – 2022 annual scholarship. The scholarship is offered once a year for students attending a four-year college. The amount of the scholarship is determined pending the funds received from donations. In addition to completing this application form, applicants will be required to submit unofficial school transcripts, and one of the following essays (see application form).

<u>Eligibility</u>: Eligibility is limited to applicants who meet all the following criteria:

- Must be a U.S. citizen
- A graduated of a U.S. high school or GED
- Attend a high school in Hamilton county, Ohio(for LiveLikeNyra scholarship)
- An incoming Freshman with full-time enrollment*
- Accepted to an Historical Black College or University (HBCU)
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.0 (HBCU Educated) or 2.25 (Live Like Nyra) see website for further information
- Single-parent household with income less than \$80,000

<u>The Application and Attachments</u>: Please provide detailed answers to all questions on the application form and submit all required attachments. All information received from applicants will be maintained in confidence. If applicable be prepared for a possible Zoom interview.

*If registration as a part-time student is due to a disability, please provide any additional information of special circumstances on a separate sheet of paper, along with any medical or psychological documents to support your claim.

Required materials for a complete application:

- A completed application. (Typed or handwritten legibly in black ink)
- Unofficial school transcripts (Winners will be required to submit official transcripts before the awards will be disbursed).
- An essay for chosen scholarship; one of two scholarships options on the application form (minimum of 500 words and a maximum of 1500 words).

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Deadline: April 16, 2021. Winners will be informed no later than July 1, 2021.
